Half a Crown (Front 9)

This event is our own scaled-down version of the popular Ben Watkinson Memorial Triple Crown Tournament.

Teams of two players, randomly chosen from entries, compete over the nine holes playing three holes of Better Ball, three holes of Scramble and three holes of Alternate Shot. Details are in the chart below.

There is a men's division and a ladies' division, which is why we play this format on “spouse-free” days. Men play from the white tees, ladies from the reds. Numbers may require one team in a division to be a threesome. If there are enough players, we'll also flight the competition. We'll have proximity markers on a couple of the par-3's, but there won't be prizes for low putts in this format, so no need to count putts separately.

Shotgun Start at 8:30 a.m.

Format	
Holes 1 - 3 Better Ball	Play your own ball, record the better (<i>best*</i>) score between (<i>among</i>) you for the hole.
Holes 4 - 6 Scramble	Both (<i>All</i>) players tee off, choose the appropriate tee shot. Each player plays from the selected location, again choose the appropriate shot. Continue until the ball is holed out.
Holes 7 - 9 Alternate Shot	Both (<i>All</i>) players tee-off, choose the appropriate tee-shot. The player whose tee shot is not chosen plays the second shot, and players alternate shots thereafter until the ball is holed out. (<i>One player whose tee shot was not chosen plays the second shot, and the remaining player plays the third shot or putt. The rotation continues until the ball is holed.</i>)

*Note: *Italicized terms substituted when a team consists of three players.*
