ScrambleSquared

(Back 9)

This event is just like a regular scramble in that the entire group is a team and will have a single score. The difference is in the order of play.

On the even-numbered holes (10, 12, 14, 16,18) the group plays a regular four-person scramble. (i.e. Each player hits a drive, the group chooses the best and each player plays the second shot from within one score-card length of that spot. The group again chooses the best resulting position, and so on until the ball is holed)

On the odd-numbered holes (11,13,15,17) things change. One player (A) hits up to 4 drives until the group is satisfied with the result. The next player in the rotation (B) hits up to 4 shots from that position, the group chooses the best and the third player (C) in the rotation plays up to 4 shots (or putts) from there and so on until the ball is holed. On the next odd-numbered hole, the second player in the rotation (B) hits the drives, the third player (C) plays the second shots, etc. Rotate again for the two remaining odd holes. Of course, if the ball is holed by the second or third player, the fourth will not play on that hole. If more than 4 shots are required, the rotation continues. Ladies tee off from the reds, men from the whites. Once established, the rotation sequence does not change.

Threesomes have to make some adjustments. On the regular scramble (even) holes, one player is chosen to hit a second drive (i.e. fourth ball) and the fourth ball on each successive shot is played in rotation. On the odd holes, the players follow the same rotating pattern as foursomes.

For people who like more analog explanations, check out the following tables. Each player in the group is represented by a different letter (A,B,C,D)

Strategy Tip: Establish your team rotation to take advantage of player strengths. e.g. have ladies driving on #15 where the red tee blocks are significantly forward.
