### Texas Scramble (Back 9)

This event is a regular four-player scramble, with a twist like a Texas tornado:

All players tee off on each hole, and the team chooses the best location of the four from which to play. From there on it's a three-person scramble, because the player whose shot is chosen sits out the subsequent shot. That person will return for the next following shot, because the team will choose the best of the three, and its author will sit out, and so on until the ball is holed. Start fresh with four tee shots on each hole.

Houston, we have a problem. Threesomes have to make some adjustments:

If you are a threesome, you will play four balls on the tee shots, and three on the other shots on each hole. The rotation for the extra tee shot should be fixed in advance, i.e. one player will hit the fourth tee shot on #10, #13 and #16, another on #11, #14, and #17, and the third on #12, #15 and #18. On the remaining shots on each hole, the team may select either of the eligible players to play the extra (third) ball.

We won't be counting putts for this event, but there will be a prize for the team that makes the longest Texas-sized putt on #15.
