



Outside Alcohol Policy

1.5 CLUBHOUSE

From August 10th, 2020 Board meeting (Amendment/update from April 20, 2009 policy)

The Parry Sound Golf & Country Club (PSG&CC) has instituted the following guidelines to ensure the safety of its staff, members and guests and to limit the possibility of over-service and intoxication. We do this to assure that all guests and members of the Parry Sound Golf & Country Club have a safe and comfortable visit and that their safety and that of others with whom they come into contact will not be jeopardized.

1. Under no circumstance may alcohol be brought onto PSG&CC property. All alcohol for purchase and consumption must be purchased by PSG&CC on our Liquor License Number as stated by the Alcohol Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO). PSG&CC reserves the right to check golf bags, coolers and other containers for unauthorized alcohol. Unauthorized alcohol will be confiscated. (AGCO*)
2. Consumption of alcohol is only allowed in/on the golf course playing area, restaurant and patios. Consumption of alcohol in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. (AGCO*)
3. The person driving a golf cart must not have an open alcohol container in his or her hand while driving. (AGCO*)
4. All alcoholic beverages for clubhouse consumption must be opened before allowing a guest to take possession.
5. Alcohol may only be sold to and consumed by people 19 years of age or older. (AGCO*)
6. PSG&CC reserves the right to refuse alcohol service.
7. If a guest appears intoxicated, service of alcohol will be stopped immediately for the remainder of their stay. If the guest becomes a “problem” they will be asked to leave and safe transportation arrangements will be made. (AGCO*)
8. Local authorities will be contacted for anyone suspected of attempting to “Drive while intoxicated”.

Any person found in breach of these rules will be recorded in an Incident report that will be filed and held on record. Also, a letter will be sent to the offender warning that he/she cannot re-offend.

If a person re-offends then a second letter will be sent out stating that they will be suspended from play at PSG&CC for 14 days and will not be permitted onto the property.

If a third offense occurs, the offender will be summoned to meet with the Board where a conclusive decision will be made.
